EMILIO PUCCI

JUNIOR SPRING/SUMMER COLLECTION 2022

Colours and prints in movement. The Junior Spring/Summer 2022 collection from Emilio Pucci has dipped in to the Maison's historic archive and chosen two iconic prints: *Lance* and *Pucci Esploso*, with a palette featuring playful explosions of bright shades like fuchsia, yellow, green, and orange.

Lance is all about exploring the city in summer and, for an ideal journey, it comes in bold, comfy shapes and asymmetrical designs with frequent sporting references. Abundant use of flounces, frills and ruffles, with drapes and pleats on dresses, skirts and t-shirts brings us a fresh feminine style, that makes full use of carefully researched fabrics. Devoré cotton overprints with 3-D effect in broderie anglaise style, soft poplins, fluid viscose, parachute cloth for wide-fitting trousers with elastic fastening, and of course, the essential jersey.

Fresh sorbet shades, including lemon yellow and mint green, with white and lavender, emphasise the fun rhythm of the logo in *Pucci Esploso*. The maxi logo is the star feature in all-over prints on cotton pique, stretch jersey, and muslin, for full-comfort items designed for movement and outdoor play: maxi tees, oversized playsuits, Bermuda shorts, beachwear and, for peak summer, a bright draped sundress or cover-ups in printed terry. The embossed logo is back on the openwork top, sweatshirts, tees, and loose-fit trousers. The scarf-detail shirt, an iconic item by the Maison, takes us back to the world of the founder, with its attention to detail and perfect research into colourways.

The beachwear alternates two graphics on one-piece costumes and bikinis in lycra, with all-over prints or solid colour with added ruffle or flounce details.

The bright colours of *Lance* and the big Pucci Esploso logo create a fun, playful collection for baby girls, with dresses, playsuits, tops, jeans, and a wealth of different accessories.

Lastly, the "Mini Me" proposals take the Farfalle print from the Resort collection for women, in two tones: milk white and moss green with wisteria. A light, airy design detail used on dresses and skirts in satin as well as on practical cotton bomber jackets, shirts and trousers, where it adds a further note of fun.

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
